This Privacy Policy describes how Personal Genome Diagnostics Inc. ("PGDx," "we", "us" or "our") handles personal information that we collect through our digital properties that link to this Privacy Policy, including our website, www.personalgenome.com, our products and services, as well as through social media, our marketing activities, and other activities described in this Privacy Policy (collectively, the "Service"). Personal information we collect

Information you provide to us. Personal information you may provide to us through the Service or otherwise includes:

- Contact data, such as your first and last name, email address, billing and mailing addresses, professional title and company name, and phone number.
- Demographic Information, such as your city, state, country of residence, and postal code.
- Profile data, such as the email address and password that you may set to establish an online account on the Service, biographical details, interests, preferences, information on whether you currently utilize NGS-based oncology assays, and any other information that you add to your account profile.

This section describes how we collect, use, and share Personal Information of California residents in our capacity as a "business" under the California Consumer Privacy Act ("CCPA") and their rights with respect to that Personal Information. Your California privacy rights. Use for new purposes. Retention. We retain personal information for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which we collected it, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements, to establish or defend legal claims, or for Compliance and protection purposes.

To determine the appropriate retention period for personal information, we consider the amount, nature, and sensitivity of the personal information, the potential risk of harm from unauthorized use or disclosure of your personal information, the purposes for which we process your personal information and whether we can achieve those purposes through other means, and the applicable legal requirements.

When we no longer require the personal information we have collected about you, we will either delete or anonymize it or, if this is not possible (for example, because your personal information has been stored in backup archives), then we will securely store your personal information and isolate it from any further processing until deletion is possible. If we anonymize your personal information (so that it can no longer be associated with you), we may use this information indefinitely without further notice to you.
